Highlights from 2013, by Cynthia Gibson Executive Director:

As we work toward our long-term goal of ensuring that active transportation in Idaho is fully funded, 2013 was a defining year. We educated over twenty-five Idaho communities on the new Community Choices for Idaho grant program, building interest and learning about their walking and biking priorities. The Community Choices for Idaho grants are funded by Transportation Alternative funds, which we worked successfully in 2012 to keep intact. Our efforts paid off with 18 communities receiving funds for biking and walking improvements. You can view the community projects at www.idahopedbike.org/resources. Thank you to our members who wrote your letters of thanks to the Idaho Transportation Department. This communication makes a difference and is part of our ongoing effort to ensure that the program continues for many years.

Idaho Pedestrian & Bicycle Alliance gained strength in 2013. I am now employed full time, working with local communities and groups. We added Valerie Connor as Executive Assistant and moved into a modest office in downtown Boise in the Union Block Building. Please stop by and say hello!

We helped Idaho move up ten places in the League of American Bicyclists' Bicycle Friendly State rankings from number 36 to 26. This is a result of improved collaboration initiated by us and includes Idaho Transportation Department and Ada County Highway District. Idaho's ranking is important as a barometer for our success. We published our ***How Biking and Walking Improve Idaho's Economy*** document (www.idahopedbike.org/resources) and use it frequently for lobbying, education and support building. We continue to make a difference at the legislature – advocating for bills that make biking and walking safer, more reliable and convenient in Idaho.

Thank you for your support in 2013 and we look forward to many successes together in 2014.

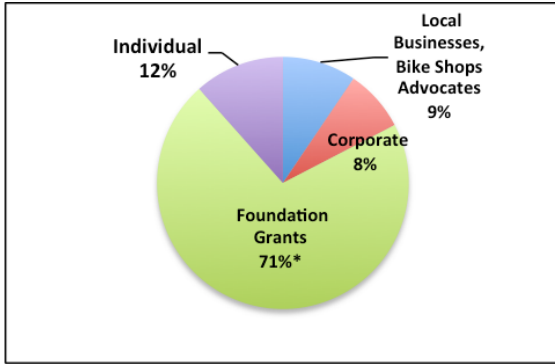

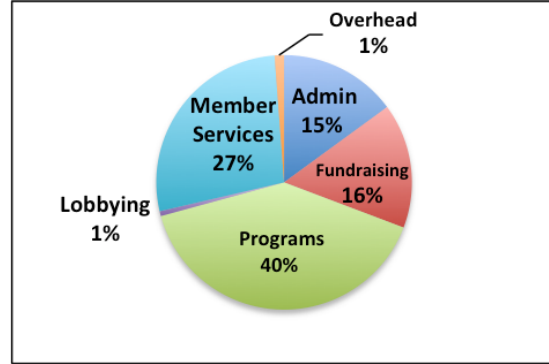
